Network on Climate Change in Bangladesh (NCC'B) is going to provide support to investigative journalists based in Bangladesh to showcase reports on different climate-change-related projects and programs. This grant would be awarded under its ongoing project '**Advocacy to Enhance Governance for the Climate Vulnerable People in Bangladesh (Phase-2)**' with financial support from the Bread for the World (BFTW), Germany.

## **TOPICS FOR CASE REPORTING**

The reporting theme would be collected from the projects funded by the Bangladesh Climate Change Trust Fund (BCCTF) which would be finalized later. We are, therefore, looking for **Four (04)** enthusiastic experienced journalists with experience in climate change and environment-related investigative journalism.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

- Be eligible for the position, applicants must have at least three (03) years of proven work experience on investigative journalism on climate change and environmental issues.
- Be a professional journalist from an established National Daily (Online media are not acceptable).
- Be committed to complete the assignment within the deadline.
- Age limit is no barrier, but previous experience is mandatory.

## **CRITERIA FOR SELECTION**

- The prospective fellow must demonstrate proven experience in integrative journalism on climate change and other environmental-related topics.
- Having a keen interest in continuing coverage of these issues in the future.

## **AWARD BENEFITS**

An honorarium would be provided based on the available fund.
