This grant would be awarded under its ongoing project '**Advocacy to Enhance Governance for the Climate Vulnerable People in Bangladesh (Phase-2)**' with financial support from the Bread for the World (BFTW), Germany.

TOPICS FOR CASE REPORTING

The reporting theme would be on climate change-related issues (NAP/Climate Financing/Low Carbon) which would be finalized later. We are therefore, looking for **two (02)** enthusiastic experienced journalists with experience in climate change and environment-related investigative journalism.

ELIGIBILITY

- To be eligible for the position, applicants must have at least three (03) year proven work experience on covering news over Climate Change and Environmental issue.
- Be a professional journalist from an established National Daily (Online media are not allowed).
- Be committed to complete the assignment within the deadline.
- Age limit is no barrier, but previous experience in mandatory.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- The prospective fellow must demonstrate proven experience in integrative journalism on climate change and other environmental-related topics.
- Having a keen interest in continuing coverage of these issues in the future.

Award Benefits

An honorarium would be provided based on the available fund.
